These are the results of the sixth Pack Poll, which has been conducted every semester since Fall, 2010. The survey was conducted online using Qualtrics survey software. Every undergraduate at NCSU had an equal probability of being invited to take the survey. This was accomplished by drawing a random sample of 4,000 students' emails. These 4,000 students were then sent an email inviting them to take part in the survey.

A total of 963 undergraduate students started the survey, and 923 completed it. The response rate for starting the survey is 24% and 23% for completing it. The margin of sampling error is +/-3.1% for questions with the maximum response rate, but it increases for questions in which the response rate is lower. For example, in "split-ballot" questions, the number of respondents answering each question is cut roughly in half, raising the margin of sampling error to about +/-4.4% for those questions.
